

Hota Bike – Your A to Z Stay



Preparing for your stay :

- ✓ Bring a backpack (personal belongings, picnic, water, charger)
- ✓ Carry sufficient water
- ✓ Adapt your clothing: some mountain passes reach 1,227 m in altitude
- ✓ Select and download your routes onto your phone before departure. Make sure your battery is fully charged.



THE PROGRAM



Mercure Delémont

Place de la Poste 10 - 2800 Delémont

Day 1 – Departure from Delémont

Your adventure begins at the Mercure Hotel, where we will meet you at the time indicated on your booking confirmation.

You can easily reach us by train, as the hotel is just a two-minute walk from the station, or by car (parking available as an option for CHF 12.– per night).

On site, you can change in a dedicated area, leave your luggage (if this option has been selected), fill your water bottles, collect your picnic (if selected), and pick up your bike (if selected), charger, and helmet.

Then it's time to head to Saint-Imier at your own pace, following the chosen itinerary.

Options (if selected) :

Bike Rental

The bicycles are provided at the Mercure in Delémont on the day of arrival and returned there at the end of your stay. They are equipped with a phone mount so you can easily follow your route using your preferred apps (no Garmin-type GPS device is provided).

A charger and helmet are supplied with your bike.

Luggage Transfer

Travel light: leave your belongings in the morning and they will be waiting for you upon arrival at each hotel.

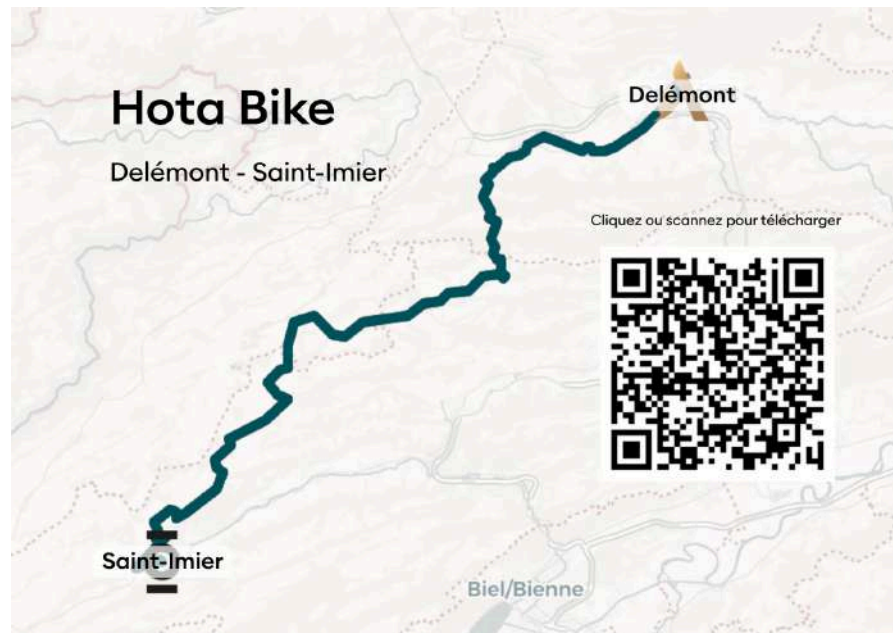

Meal available at [Auberge de Bellelay](#) (Bellelay) or [Chez Nico](#) (Les Reussilles)

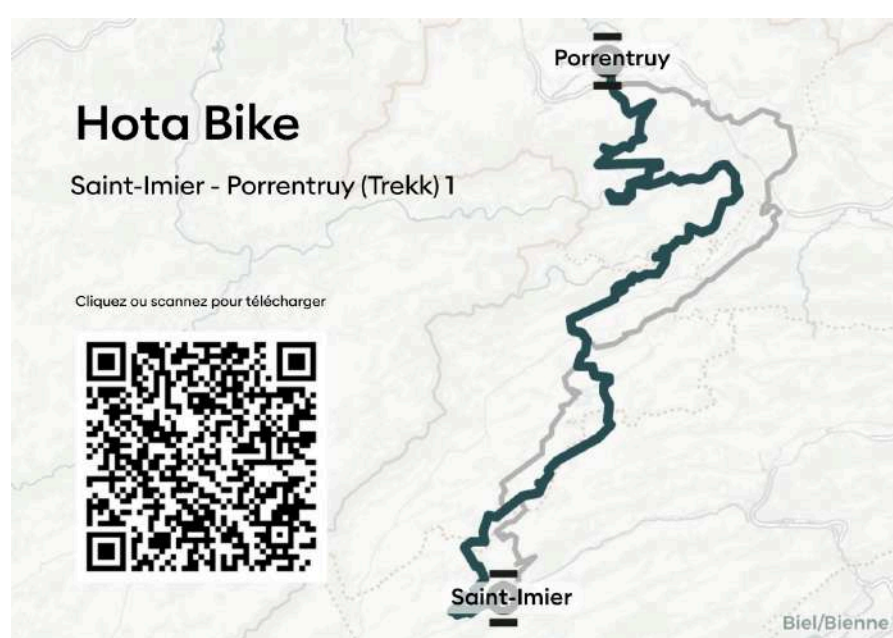
Hota Hotel Saint-Imier

Meal available at [Auberge de la Couronne](#) or [Bellevue](#) (Saignelégier)

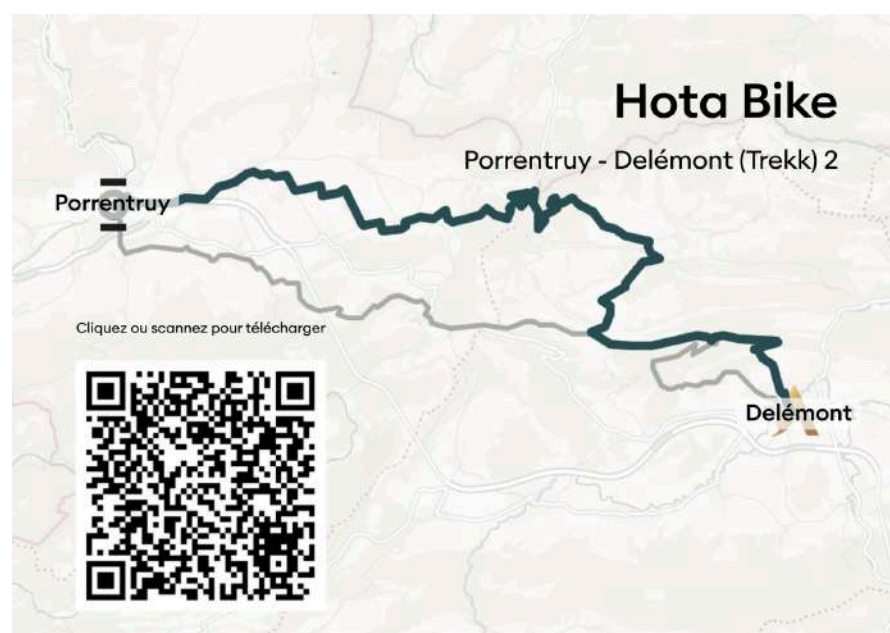
Hota Hotel Porrentruy
